STEP 1: SELECT YOUR EXPERIENCE

The Signature Experience (1–3 Hours)

\$1,500 – \$3,500

Best for: High-impact + flexible engagement

- Ideal for keynotes, workshops, or blended sessions
- Can include 1–3 modules depending on time
- Light to moderate interaction

Perfect for schools wanting impact without a full-day commitment

The Intensive Experience (Half-Day | 3–4 Hours)

\$3,000 – \$5,500

Best for: Skill-building + deeper engagement

- Multiple modules combined
- Interactive discussions + applied learning
- Strong balance of teaching + participation

The Immersion Experience (Full Day | 6–8 Hours)

\$5,000 – \$8,500

Best for: Full training + transformation

- Multi-module experience
- Role-play, application, and coaching
- Deeper engagement and skill development

The Mastery Experience (Two-Day Intensive)

\$8,500 – \$15,000+

Best for: Career readiness + communication mastery

- Advanced training and repetition

MODULES

MODULE MENU WITH CUSTOMIZATION OPTIONS

1. Professional Development Lecture

60 minutes

Type: Lecture-Style Session

Focus Areas (choose 1–2):

- Professionalism in the workplace (attitude, accountability, communication)
- Transitioning from student mindset to professional mindset
- Time management and responsibility in leadership roles
- Workplace expectations vs. college expectations
- Personal brand and reputation building

2. Interview Preparation & Career Readiness

60–90 minutes

Type: Workshop Experience (Lecture + Interactive)

Focus Areas (choose 1–2):

- Translating RA experience into resume language
- Answering common interview questions with confidence
- Behavioral interview techniques (STAR method)
- Professional communication and body language
- First impressions and interview presence

3. Confidence Building & Personal Presence (with Debate)

3–4 hours

Type: Interactive Training (Hands-On)

Focus Areas:

- Finding and owning your voice
- Speaking with confidence under pressure
- Debate fundamentals (structured arguments and rebuttals)
- Overcoming fear of judgment or being wrong
- Building presence in leadership and group settings

4. Conflict Resolution & Difficult Conversations

60–90 minutes

Type: Workshop Experience (Lecture + Interactive)

Focus Areas (choose 1–2):

- Managing peer-to-peer conflict
- Addressing roommate or resident issues
- Communication during high-emotion situations
- Setting boundaries professionally
- De-escalation techniques

5. Leadership in Action (RA Scenario Training)

60–90 minutes

Type: Interactive Training (Hands-On)

Focus Areas (choose 1–2):

- Decision-making in real-time situations
- Handling responsibility and accountability
- Leadership under pressure
- Ethical decision-making
- Supporting residents while maintaining authority

6. Bridging the Gap: Generational Workplace Communication

60–90 minutes

Type: Lecture-Style Session (with guided discussion)

Focus Areas (choose 1–2):

- Understanding generational differences (Gen Z vs. older leadership)
- Communication expectations in professional environments
- Receiving and responding to feedback
- Navigating authority and workplace hierarchy
- Work ethic, professionalism, and perception

7. “Let’s Talk About It” – Real Conversations

60–90 minutes

Type: Lecture-Style Session (discussion-based)

Focus Areas (customized conversation):

- Real-life challenges students are facing
- Balancing personal life, school, and responsibility
- Relationships, boundaries, and self-worth
- Growth, mistakes, and learning experiences
- Open dialogue guided by student engagement

8. Interactive Role-Play Experience

60–120 minutes

9. Mock Interview Experience (Advanced)

3–4 hours

10. Public Speaking & Presentation Mastery (Signature Training)

Full Day (6–8 hours) OR Two-Day Expansion

Focus Areas (multi-part training):

- Speech writing and structure
- Organizing ideas clearly and effectively
- Rehearsal and memorization techniques
- Vocal delivery, tone, and pacing

- Body language and stage presence
- Overcoming speaking anxiety
- Live presentation and feedback

IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW

FACILITATION & ENGAGEMENT STRUCTURE

- Up to **50 participants** → facilitated by Dr. Rox
- Larger groups → **additional facilitators required for interactive workshops**
- **1 facilitator per additional up to 25 participants \$300 – \$750 per facilitator (per session/day)**
 - 1-50 One facilitator (Dr. Rox)
 - 51-75 two facilitators etc...

TRAVEL & LODGING

Travel and lodging are not included in the training investment and will be covered by the client for in-person engagements outside of the local service area.

Clients may either:

- Book airfare and hotel accommodations directly, or
- Request that arrangements be made on their behalf and reimbursed accordingly

BOOKING & PAYMENT TERMS

- A non-refundable deposit of **25%** is required to secure your date
- Remaining balance is due **prior to the scheduled training date**
- Dates are not confirmed until deposit is received

CANCELLATION & RESCHEDULING

- Cancellations made within **30 days** of the event may be subject to a fee
- Rescheduling is permitted based on availability
- Deposits are non-refundable but may be applied to a future date
